- ❖ All together traditional farewell lunch (optional)



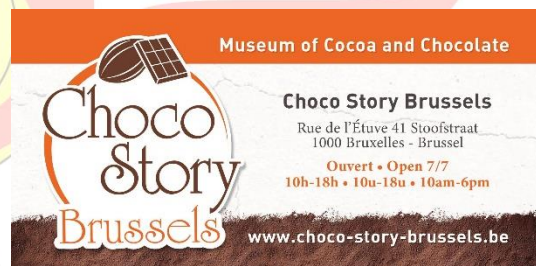
As for the partners' program:
